Knowing how to properly apply athletic ability, fighting skills, and tactical thinking is an important requirement for KAPAP ACADEMY instructors, but you will also need to know how to teach others to do it.

KAPAP ACADEMY Instructor certification program courses help you develop the additional knowledge, skills and techniques needed to organize and open an authorized School and teach our world class courses, and workshops based on the KAPAP ACADEMY curriculum.

All the Instructor certification courses are conducted by KAPAP ACADEMY Instructors who are responsible for the certification program and under direct supervision of the head of School.

To qualify as an KAPAP ACADEMY Instructor:

1. Candidates must have at least two years of previous Martial Arts, Self Defense, Military Combative, or defensive tactics training when applying to the Instructor Program.
2. Candidates will be required to demonstrate teaching skills required to be successful during an instructor training course. by completing pre-course questionnaires, and qualification exercises(Videoed tasks) administered by the Director of training.
3. Candidates must satisfactorily complete a KAPAP ACADEMY Instructor Training Course in the discipline they wish to teach (e.g., KAPAP ACADEMY L1 Course), and receive the endorsement of the KAPAP ACADEMY Training director.
4. KAPAP ACADEMY Instructor courses are discipline specific. During the course, candidates will learn Instruction policies and procedures, basic public speaking skills, training methodology, use of a training team and training aids, organizing a course, building a budget, and finally preparing to teach.
5. Candidates will be provided two packets: Student's packet and Trainer's Packet. Packets will include KAPAP ACADEMY appropriate Lesson Plans and Outlines.

6. Role-playing is a major part of an instructor course; therefore, the minimum class size should be at least 6 with 10-12 candidates being ideal. Role-playing includes candidates taking turns working in teams teaching portions of the course to other candidates who role-play students.
7. KAPAP ACADEMY Director of training will evaluate candidates' performance based on their ability to handle the material with confidence, use of appropriate training aids, following the lesson plans and meeting all learning objectives, while utilizing the teaching philosophies expected of KAPAP ACADEMY Certified Instructors.
8. Candidates can also expect to learn the KAPAP ACADEMY discipline specific instructional methods and evaluating and improving the performance of beginning students.
9. Once candidates completed the KAPAP ACADEMY L1 course they must complete a one year probationary term and are evaluated by KAPAP ACADEMY LLC. they are then approved to teach **only in good standing** with the Instructor License agreement.
